

Welsh Treasures, Botanic Gardens and the Royal Mint

Based in the capital city of Wales, this tour captures the essence of Welsh culture and spectacular scenery, in addition to including a visit to one of the most interesting new attractions in many years: The Royal Mint Visitor Centre. Since decimal coinage was introduced, the Royal Mint has been at Llantrisant, but for half of its 1,000 year history it was located in the Tower of London. It now produces coins and medals for over 60 countries worldwide.

Day 1 We make our way into South Wales stopping enroute at the ancient city of Worcester.

Day 2 A visit to the National Botanic Gardens of Wales. Nestled in the Tywi Valley, the garden combines themed displays, rolling parkland and secluded woodland. The award winning Great Glasshouse is home to a profusion of rare, fragrant, exotic and even spooky plants. Continue to Carmarthen, one of Wales' oldest towns, before returning to the hotel.

Day 3 Today begins with admission to the Royal Mint Visitor Centre, for an escorted tour of the production process. From here, enjoy an engaging, self-guided tour of static and interactive exhibits, bringing to life the Mint's heritage. This afternoon, we include an introductory tour in the attractive city centre of Cardiff, as well as the modernised Cardiff Bay with its fascinating public buildings, including the Welsh Assembly.

Day 4 An excursion to the foothills of the Brecon Beacons National Park and a morning visit to the award winning Big Pit Museum to learn about the region's heritage. As well as tour, there is also a virtual tour above ground, providing a moving and entertaining illustration of the lives of miners at work and home. This afternoon visit Penderwyn Visitor Centre to learn about whisky making in Wales and general Welsh history in the exhibition centre.

Day 5 Homeward journey, travelling via the border town of Monmouth, we expect to be home mid evening.

Lincolnshire... 'Bomber County'

Lincolnshire is often considered the spiritual home of military aviation in the UK, playing a vital role in WWI and WWII.

Local airfields were bases for the famous wartime squadrons and now offer visitors the chance to relive those memories. This rich heritage coupled with the beauty of the Lincolnshire Wolds and coastline make for an unforgettable experience.

Day 1 Travelling to Newark with free time to explore this historic market town before an included visit to the Newark Air Museum. From just one aircraft, Newark Air Museum is now home to over 70 aircraft and cockpit sections. Newark Air Museum is now one of the largest independent aviation museums in the UK. We then travel to Louth with tea/coffee on arrival at the Kenwick Park Hotel.

Whilst in Lincolnshire the following programme is included:

- Morning visit to the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight Visitor Centre at RAF Coningsby, for a guided tour. Later attend the Down Memory Lane cinema show. Relive cinema as it was in its heyday with vintage clips, classic adverts and sing-a-long films.
- Spend some time in the historic cathedral city of Lincoln for sightseeing before heading to RAF Digby and its Lima Sector operations room. The only one of

its type left in the country and now fully restored from original artefacts found on site. There are several rooms telling the story of Digby's role in the Battle of Britain and beyond.

- A day to explore Lincolnshire's pretty coastline. Visiting Mablethorpe and Skegness, two classic holiday destinations prior to visiting the Lincolnshire Aviation Heritage Centre. It is now widely seen as a living memorial to the 55,500 men of Bomber Command who lost their lives during WW2.

Day 5 Set in beautiful rural Lincolnshire, we visit the huge Hemswell Antique Centres. Once part of RAF Hemswell – the home of the Lancaster Bomber during the Second World War – the centres now offer a wonderful mix of antiques and collectables from bygone times. Expected arrival home will be late afternoon/early evening.



This is the only place in the UK where you can see Britain's three V Bombers: the Vulcan, Victor and Valiant.


